### Matters Arising

Thames Water	PS has provided a history of local flooding by postcode. Thames Water are asking an outside contractor to design a scheme for a proposed new pumping station at Kingston Stert which will pump directly to the far side of Emmington. The planning and costing has been agreed, but the scheme is not guaranteed to go ahead.	
Footpath sign	Peter Quinton is going to provide a quote to compare to that from Arien Signs. The finish of the sign to be queried with Arien.	PS HM
Footpaths	The application to divert Bridleway 7 has been withdrawn, so no consultation is proceeding at the moment.	
Community Led Plan	Following feedback from the last meeting it was suggested that the Parish Council put more information in the newsletter about the subjects currently being discussed. The Parish Council part of the website to be progressed.	HM
Flosacks	The details and fliers have been distributed.	
Road cleaning	A request to be made for the roadside cleaning to be carried out and for the gullies to be jetted too.	HM
VAS sign	Solargen have credited the repair invoice in full.	
Local transport plan 2011-2030	A response has been submitted in favour of the cycle link with Henton and the Park & Ride scheme at Lewknor.	
Flytipping	The incident on the Stert road has been reported by both our parish council and that of Aston Rowant. The debris still remains so a follow up report to be made.	HM
HGV traffic	There is a lobby by Aston Rowant and Chinnor councils to try and get the B4009 graded as unsuitable for HGV traffic and to stop GPS satnavs directing traffic to Thame via Chinnor or Kingston Blount. Sydenham may also need to look at this if the lobby is successful - our MP to be approached. There have been complaints from Brookstones residents regarding the heavy traffic using the route to the farms. A letter to be drafted to the landowners possibly concerned.	PS DOF/JP
Speeding	For the next stage of the Speed Awareness program, data needs to be collected using sets of cables across the road. These cables would cost £120 plus VAT per set. It was agreed that two sets of cables should be purchased, the locations of which to be decided between the parish council, the community led plan committee and Jacky Maddon.	HM
Mundays Gift	A letter has been received from the Charity Commission with further information required.	HM
